Glacier Lane Colleague Accommodations Informational Brochure “Private Rentals”

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Hello;

You may not be a Fairmont Colleague at this time, but we offer the opportunity to rent within our colleague accommodations as a non-colleague or what we call as a 'private renter' throughout various times of the year, primarily March-November. Winter season private rentals are scarce as we may need more beds for colleagues.

This information was compiled to provide you with some details of the accommodations that we provide; what the rooms look like, what amenities are available, our operations, costs, and some general information about living in colleague accommodations.

Should you be interested in becoming a private renter with us, we ask that you fill out an application form. This form is available upon request in our office, or via email.

A private renter is allowed to rent a room in one of our quad units. A Quad unit is a two bedroom apartment in which each of the bedrooms have a bunk bed set up, enabling us to house four people to a unit. The bathroom, kitchen and living room are to be shared amongst the roommates in the unit equally. We do our best at trying to allow for private renters to have their own bedroom and only share the unit with one other person; however it is never guaranteed, as if we should get many private rentals we will place up to four people in a unit. On the next page, there are photos to show you a typical quad room.

Once you have been accepted to reside in our accommodations, a notification would be sent to you, preferably by email, however it can be done over the phone or in person in the housing office. At this time, information regarding check in costs (such as a \$300.00 damage deposit) would be discussed and a potential arrival date.

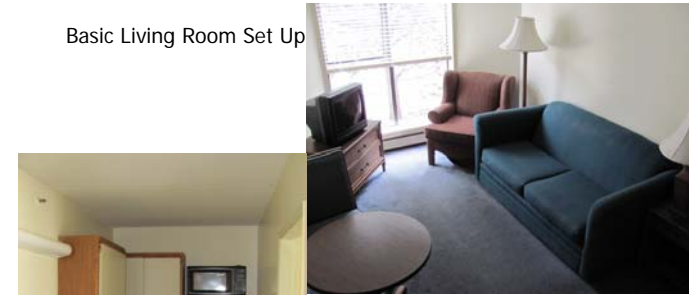
Each two bedroom unit comes fully furnished. We provide furniture for the bedrooms (dressers, lamps), furniture for the living rooms (sofa's, tables, chairs, lamps), shower curtain for the bathrooms, as well as kitchen items (microwave, toaster oven, fridge/freezer, stovetop, dishes, cutlery, glasses/mugs, pots/pans. We DO NOT provide TV's, alarm clocks, radios/stereos, toasters, ovens, kettles, coffee makers, blenders etc. The rooms are set up so that the living room separates the two bedrooms. Linen packages (bedding, pillow, towels) are available from the housing office for a one time fee of \$35.00 (the cost of cleaning the package when you are finished with them), or if you don't need the whole package, items are available on an individual basis. These items are also all available to be purchased brand new from our Housing Store if you wish to keep them when you move out from housing. The Bathrooms are set up so the sink and mirror are located outside separately from the toilet and shower, which enables multiple

colleagues to get ready at once (while one is in the shower, the other can utilize the sink and mirror.)

Rent is payable on a nightly basis and collected every 14 days in advance. The current rate is 15.75 a night, so for a 14 night period the total payable is \$220.50. This rate includes cable and hydro, it does not include telephone or internet. For example if you moved in on June 4th, you would need to pay \$220.50 to rent from June 4th through to and including June 17th. Your next rental payment is due on June 18th for the next 14 nights. All Private renter rent is payable 14 days in advance. Any rent increase, is reviewed annually between Human Resources and the Colleague Accommodations Manager. If there is to be an increase, a notice would be sent to all residents at least a month prior to it taking place.

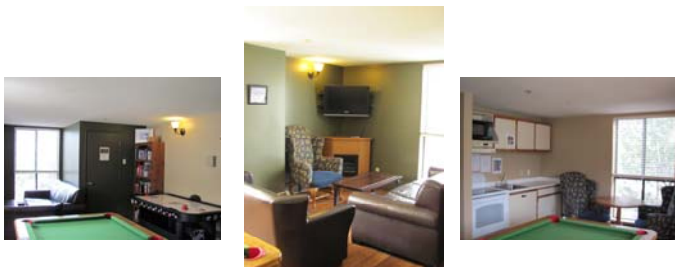
While we understand and realize that its not always easy living 'dorm style', we believe in creating a home away from home for you, and want you to enjoy your time with us. There are many different services and amenities available to you, to utilize as a resident within our Glacier Lane buildings.

We offer a 24 hour laundry room service in both buildings. The machines are card operated. Cards are available from the Housing office for a \$10.00 refundable deposit, and you are able to load the card with money on the card machine located outside our Office. The cards are to be returned to the Office upon your departure, for the return of your \$10.00. The Laundry rooms are equipped with 3 washers and 6 dryers, as well as a beverage vending machine.

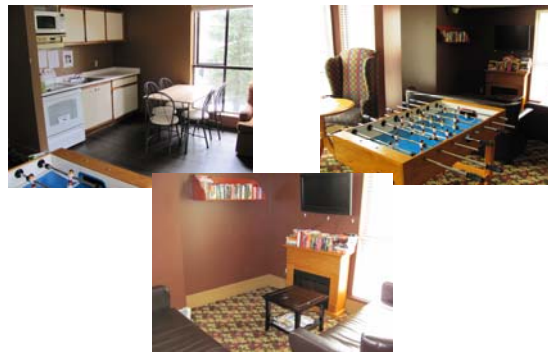


We have Lounges available from 11:00am-11:00pm in both buildings. They are located on the second floor of each building and offer an alternative to sitting in your unit. They are equipped with a TV and fireplace, oven (the only rooms in each building with a proper oven to use) /stovetop, microwave, as well as a bookshelf in which you can donate used books to or borrow one if you wish to read it. The B3 lounge offers a air hockey table and a pool table, beverage vending machine, and the B4 lounge offers a Foosball table.

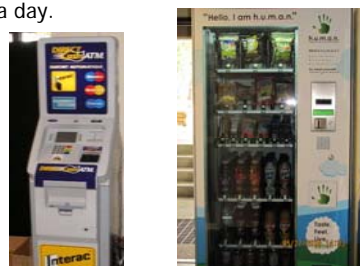


Canada Day BBQ and Road Hockey Tournament

There is a 24 hour ATM located up at housing, as well as vending machines that provide beverages and snacks 24 hours a day.



The Housing Office has a Mini-Mart in which we offer basic food and cleaning items for sale at affordable costs. Things like, dish detergent, laundry detergent, toilet paper, chocolate bars, pasta and pasta sauces, Kraft dinner, pizza pops, freezies, bread, soups/canned goods, printing, faxes, stamps, long distance phone cards, Pilipino food items and much more.

Want to Watch a Movie? We offer free rentals of DVD's and VHS from the Housing office. These VHS's and DVD's have been donated by previous tenants as they have departed Housing.
