Things to Do: There is skiing in the winter and boating and sailing in the summer. There are many hiking trails around as well. Sports and activities such as basketball, tennis, soccer, volleyball, etc. available at the local school. Community education activities such as aerobics, and English as a second language. Some students have helped tutor in Spanish at our local school. Churches are offering more things to do, such as pot luck dinners, and movie nights. Travel Instructions: Students are encouraged to fly all the way to the regional airport in Duluth, Minnesota if possible. From the Minneapolis/Saint Paul airport you can fly to Duluth. There are 2 ways to travel to Duluth if you fly into Minneapolis. 1) Jefferson Bus Line Go to the basement of the airport and take the Jefferson Bus Line (www.jeffersonlines.com) into St Paul, then transfer onto a bus that will stop in Minneapolis and then continue on to Duluth (make sure you ask Jefferson Bus for a ticket straight to Duluth when you get on at the airport.) 2.) Skyline Shuttle www.skylineshuttle.com 1.888.354.2677 Reservations STRONGLY recommended, credit card needed. Approximately \$42 one way from airport to Duluth (Radisson Hotel is the drop off. Please notify employer as soon as you have travel plans arranged as Grand Marais is 2 hours from Duluth so they will need to make arrangements to pick you up.
